A hired vehicle is currently in use as the municipal vehicle is old.</p> <p><b>Kouga LM:</b> No Official Vehicle</p>
<p>4. whether Mayors and/or Speakers are entitled to receive a car allowance from their respective municipalities if they have been allocated official vehicles; if so, why;</p>	<p>It must first be corrected that no municipality provides any councillor with a car allowance. The packages for councillors are in the form of a “total cost to company”, which means if a councillor structures his/ her package such that it allows for a car allowance, that money comes from the own package of the councillor. It is an individual choice of a Mayor or Speaker to structure his package to accommodate for a car allowance. Even if one has done that such structuring, he can also use a municipal vehicle if he wants to but cannot do a fuel claim when he has used a municipal vehicle.</p>

QUESTION	RESPONSE
	Use of a municipal vehicle when one has structured is not prohibited but can create a challenge for one with SARS.
5. whether any Mayor, Deputy Mayor or Speaker in the province have received free or subsidized housing from a municipality; if so, (a) which municipality and (b) why?	<p><b>Amathole DM:</b> The institution has a state house that is allocated to the Executive Mayor. However, when the term ends, he or she leaves the state house for the next Executive Mayor.</p> <p><b>Joe Gqabi DM:</b> There is a Mayoral House which is currently not occupied. It is intended to be used as a rental house intention is to generate income.</p> <p><b>Senqu LM:</b> The municipality has an existing Mayoral House which is used by the Mayor.</p> <p><b>Engcobo LM:</b> The Mayor is staying at the Municipal Mayoral house, No subsidy is received by him</p>
